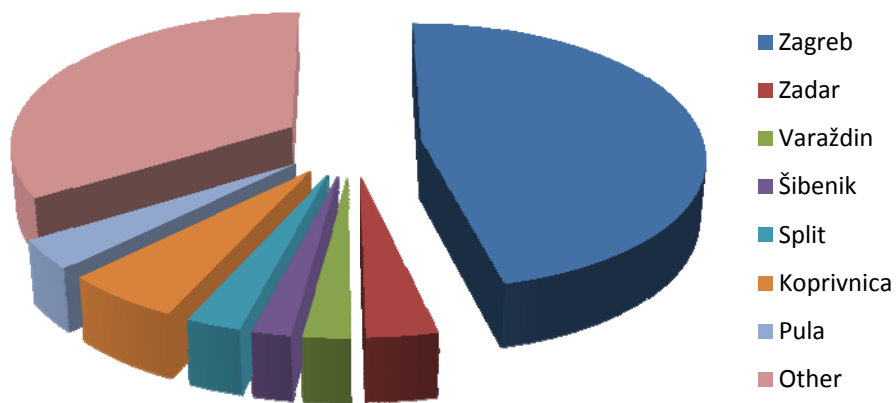

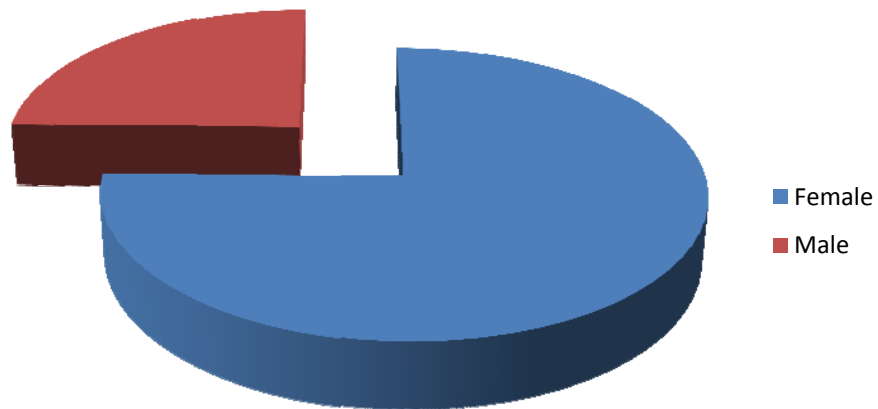

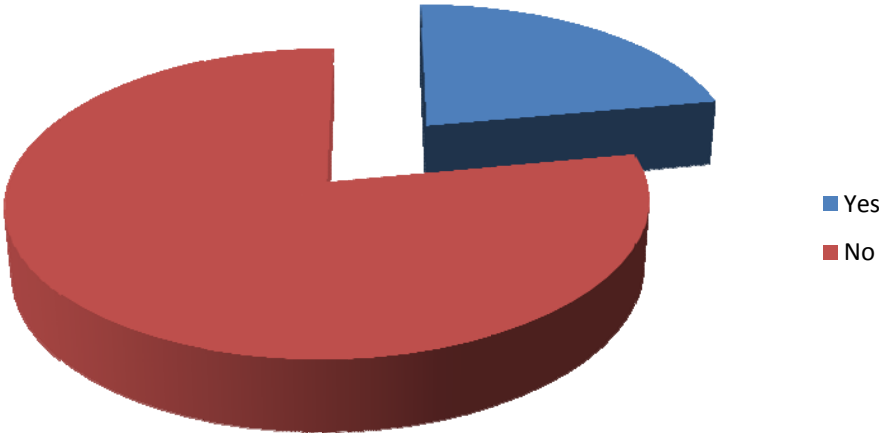

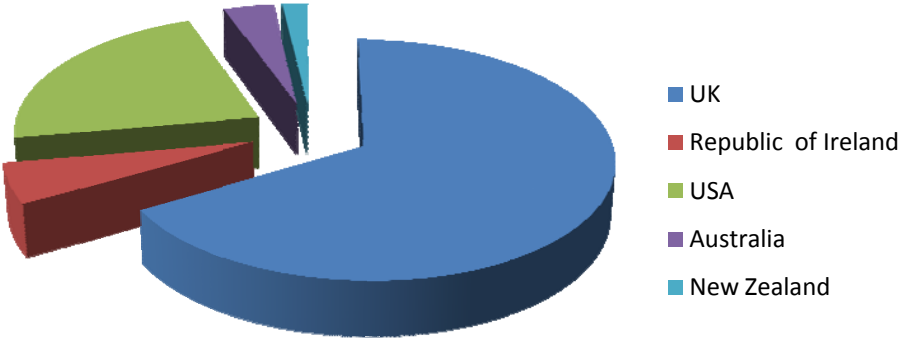

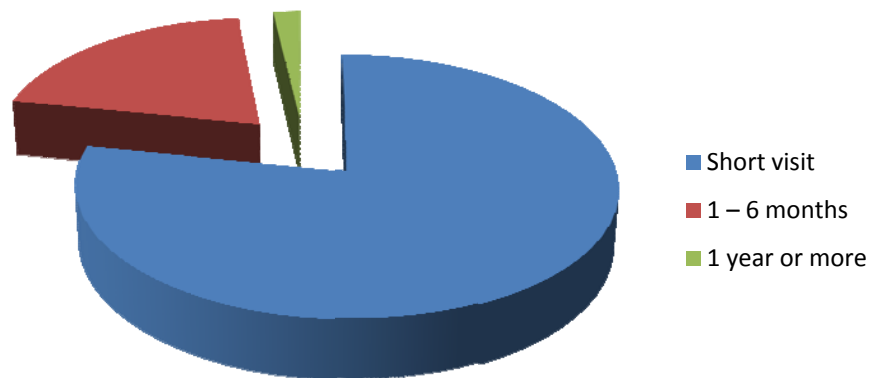

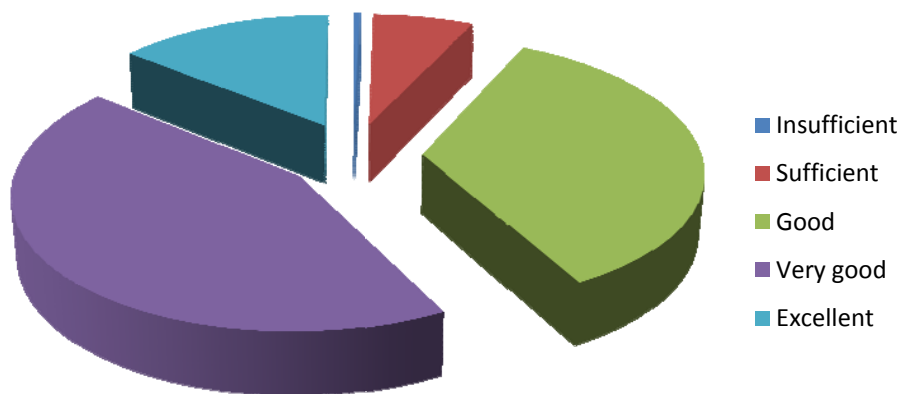

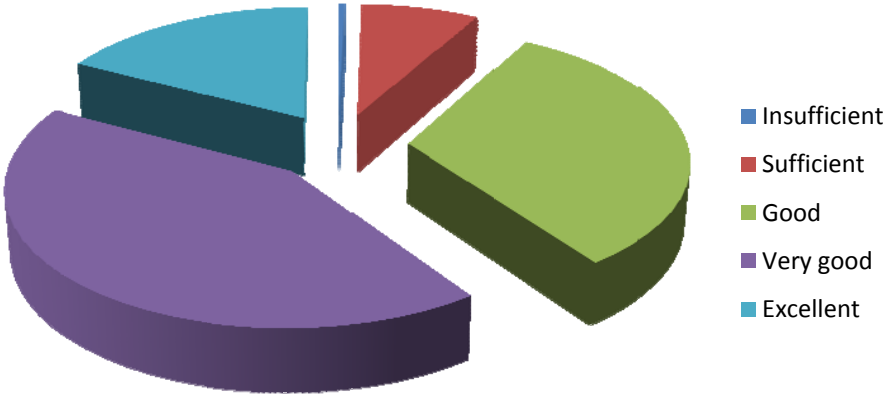

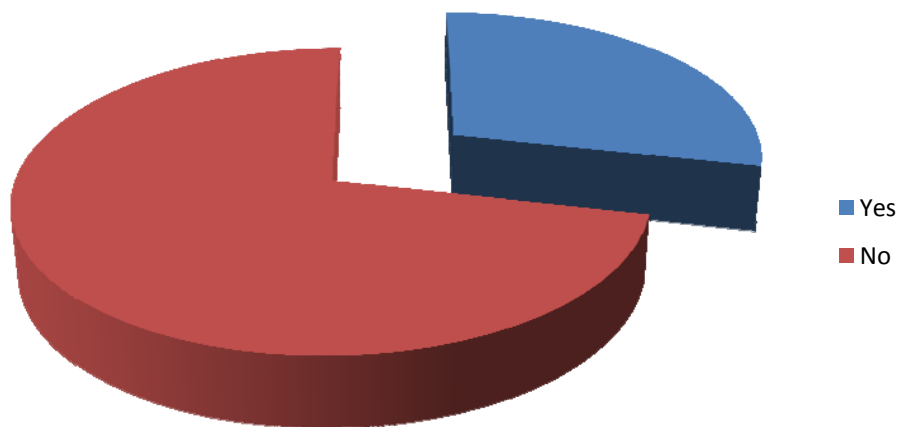

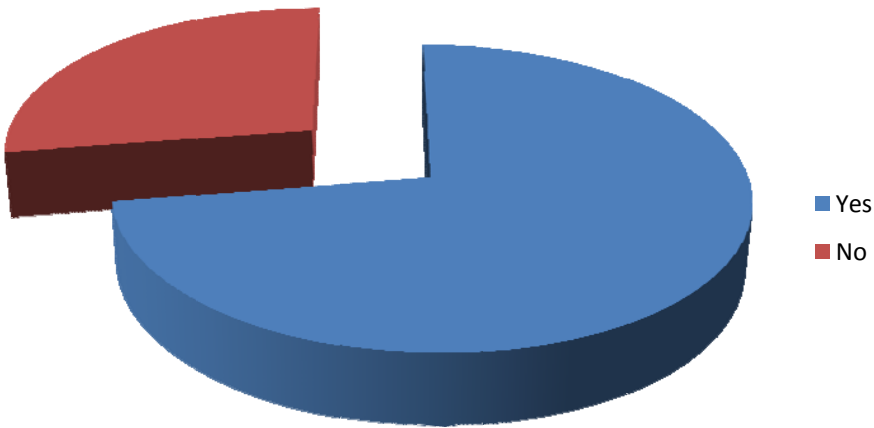

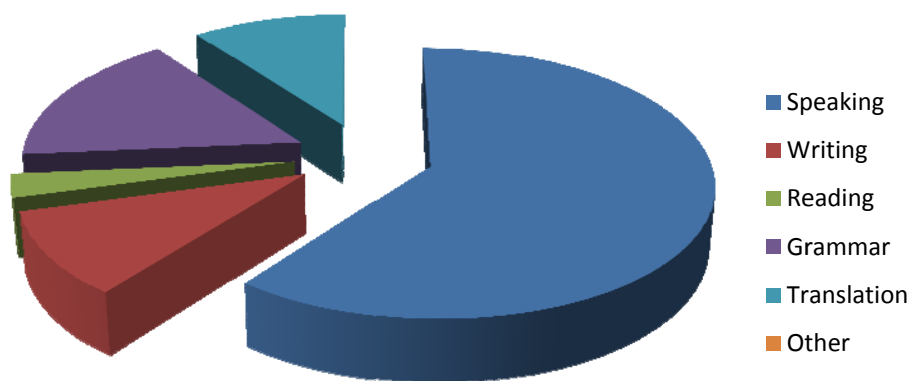

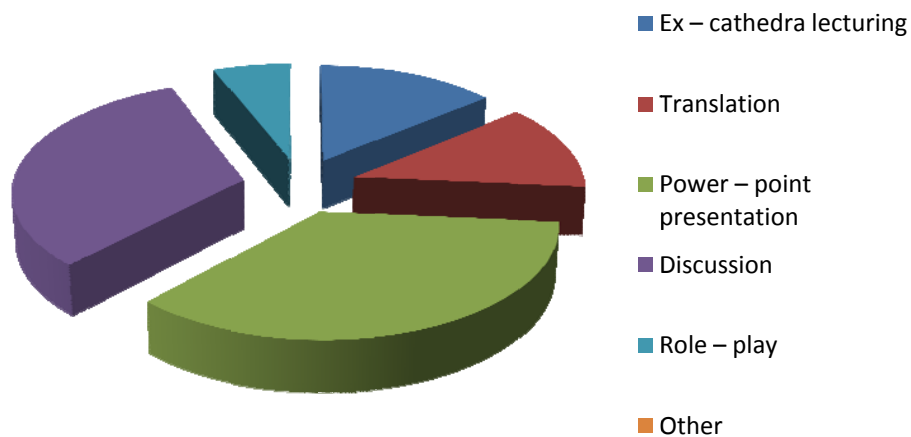

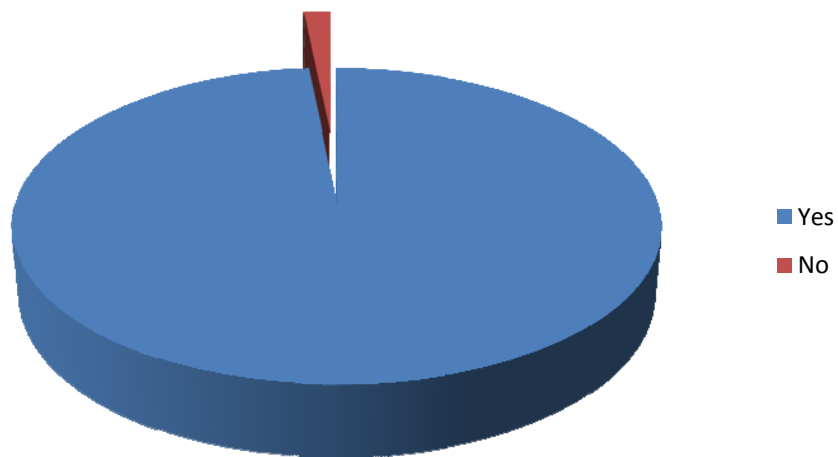

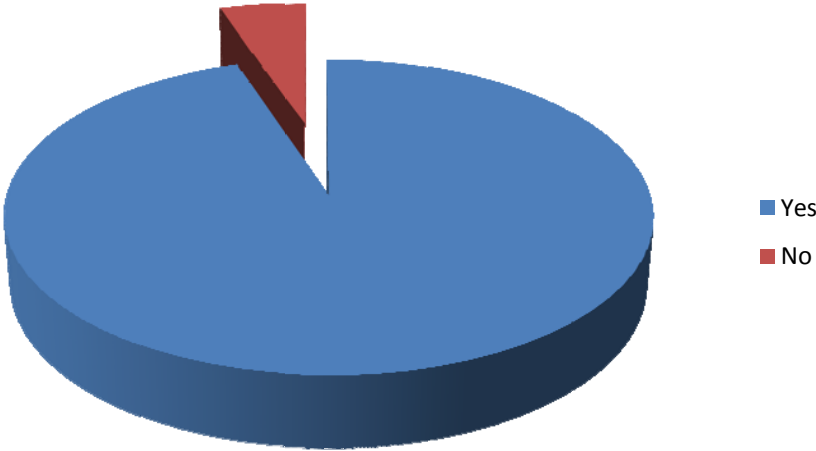
Q18: Do you think English is important for your profession?
